



### **Description of Organization**

Grace on Wings, Inc is a nonprofit public charity organization under IRS code 501(c) (3) that provides charity air ambulance service which is based out of the Indianapolis International Airport. We are the only charity air ambulances, which is licensed and certified in United States.

### **Mission Statement**

Grace on Wings shares the love of Christ through the gift of aviation by providing cost-effective fixed-wing transport for medical patients in need throughout the Midwest.

### **Who Qualifies for Assistance?**

To qualify, the patient must:

- be non-ambulatory
- require medical care en route.
- lack the financial resources or insurance coverage to pay for a commercial air ambulance service.
- not have active or untreated MRSA, VRE, or TB.

### **Target Population & Benefit**

Grace on Wings provides cost-effective medical airplane transport for individuals needing to travel to or from the Midwest area for treatment. Our charity air ambulance service is available for those:

- Too ill for commercial flight*
- Too ill for long distance ground transportation*
- Unable to afford transportation to access critical medical care located at a distance*

To be eligible, you or a family member must have a condition requiring medically-supervised transport of a distance of at least 150 miles.

### **Volunteers**

Grace on Wings is staffed with professionals who volunteer their time. Our chief pilot has specialized MU-2 training and has over 4000 flight hours. Flights taken are always flown with the chief pilot, a trained co-pilot, and two trained medical crew members including a physician assistant, RN or EMT-P.
